### PROBLEM STATEMENT

Submit a solution implemented by your state or city that has benefited the department, and citizens, or addressed any urban challenge/problem/issue.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Entries must be submitted by a state, city, union territory, parastatal agency, or any other administrative body.

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- **Type of Submission:** A short presentation or video showcasing a good practice related to any of the 10 themes, emphasizing the journey from planning to implementation.
- **Judging Criteria:**
  - Submissions will be evaluated based on impact, scalability, replicability, innovation and the quality of the presentation
  - Shortlisted entries will be open for public voting
  - The entries with the highest votes under each sub-category, along with the final decision of the committee will be declared the winners

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

- To qualify for Urban Learnathon 2.0, the submitted solution must have been successfully implemented within the last five years. This ensures that the solutions are both relevant and practically applicable.
- The submitted solution must clearly demonstrate alignment with one or more of the ten specified themes outlined in the submission guidelines. This alignment is essential for evaluating the solution's relevance to the competition's objectives and for facilitating meaningful comparisons between submissions.
- Submissions should clearly articulate the solution's impact on the urban environment and its potential for replication or scaling in other contexts.
- Participants must confirm that they hold the rights to the submitted solution and that it does not infringe upon the intellectual property of others.
- Ensure that submissions are original and have not been previously awarded in ISAC Awards or any other national or international competition, nor entered in Learnathon 1.0.
